Primary care provider	For help finding a primary care provider (PCP), call Rocky Mountain Health Plans Prime at 1-888-282-8801
Referral process	No referral needed to see specialists in the Rocky Mountain Health Plan network
Extra benefits	No co-pay for primary care visits

You may opt out of your managed care plan for any reason during the first **90** days of your enrollment. You may also opt out each year during the **60** days before the first day of your birth month. If you leave your managed care plan, you will still belong to a regional organization that can help you with physical and behavioral health benefits.
