

## Do You Use Non-Emergent Medical Transportation?

Non-Emergent Medical Transportation (NEMT) is a Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) benefit for members who need transportation to medical appointments. Health First Colorado covers rides to and from the nearest doctor's office, hospital, or another medical office for covered care and services. An NEMT driver should:

- Only take you to the appointment and then home;
- Always take the most direct route to the appointment and back home;
- Never offer you money or other incentives.
